



### **Specialist Anaesthetist**

Title: Specialist Anaesthetist	Reporting To: Head of Anaesthetics
Business Unit: Surgery	Classification Level: Fractional Specialist

### **Position Purpose:**

This role is responsible for providing anaesthetic services to patients having oral surgical and dental procedures at The Royal Dental Hospital (RDHM), as per the Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists (ANZCA) guidelines. This includes participation in pre-operative preparation and optimisation, in addition to provision of anaesthetic services, for our day stay patients.

### **Role Accountabilities:**

### Role Specific

- Pre-operative assessment and preparation of patients undergoing dentalrelated surgery as necessary
- Conduct patient assessment and provide anaesthesia services as per current ANZCA professional documents
- Provide acute resuscitation services across RDHM for medical emergencies
- Support the post-operative care of patients in the Post Anaesthetic Care Unit (PACU) ensuring safe discharge within day surgery guidelines
- Assist with preoperative screening processes by reviewing medical questionnaires
- Assess patients in the pre-anaesthetic clinic
- Participate in the on-call roster







- Support the functioning of the Day Surgery Unit (DSU) as directed by Head of Anaesthetics
- Adhere to the principles of Infection Control in accordance with DHSV protocol and practices
- Participate in clinical review and quality assurance sessions
- Participate in continuing professional education to maintain personal knowledge and skills as required to maintain specialist registration
- Identify and make recommendations on opportunities to improve processes, workplace health and safety, quality and service delivery outcomes within DHSV
