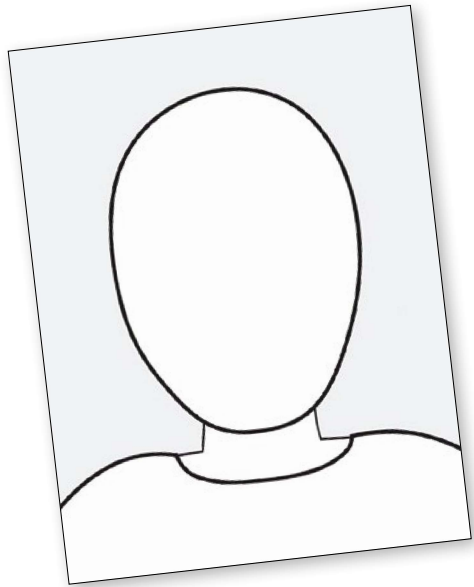


Activity: Show me your smile



Key messages for children

- ★ Teeth are an important part of our body.
- ★ Teeth have three main jobs – smiling, talking and eating.
- ★ Healthy means that you are not sick and that your body feels good. It means you can play, learn and grow.
- ★ Teeth can get sick. It's important to look after our teeth.

What you will need

- ★ Copy of a **blank face outline** for each child
- ★ Crayons or textas

What to do

Give each child a copy of the blank face outline. Ask the children to draw their smiles on the face (and any other features they wish to show – eyes, eyebrows, nose, and so on).

Ask children

Talk to the children about what their mouth and teeth do.

To help us smile (eat and talk).
